NEXT LEVEL- IES and Other Initiatives

At ACE-DHH Pittsburgh, over 30 people met to think about ways to continue the research and grant initiatives. The first submission due date for the **Institute of Educational Sciences** grants was July 24 and the team of Dee Klein, Kate Reynolds, Mary V. Compton, Susan Lenihan, Karen Stein, and Kathy Kreimeyer submitted a \$1.6 million proposal in the Early Intervention funding track. Award decisions will be made in November and funding becomes available in March 2008.

John Luckner is also working on an IES proposal for the next submission date in November.

Harold Johnson is busy once again pursuing funding to look at Child Abuse and Neglect with deaf and hard of hearing children.
